Beginner/Intermediate/Advanced Stained Glass Classes:

Beginner: Evening

Learn the basics of stained glass and learn to do things right the first time! In this relaxed skill-based course you will create a sun-catcher and a hanging panel for your window. We have a selection of unique designs for you to choose from, geared to the beginner student. This course provides detailed instruction in handling, cutting, grinding, foiling, and soldering your stained glass. *This is a 5 week course plus 1 additional make-up class - in case you have to miss a class (Of course even if you don't miss any days you're quite welcome to come along to the make-up).*

Intermediate/Advanced: Evening

Never stop Learning! Students work on their chosen project while improving techniques and learning new skills. This is a popular class as you can be adventurous in your choice of pattern, whilst having the security of an experienced instructor to help you every step of the way. We recommend that you choose a pattern prior to the first class. We are always here during store hours to help you with advice on your choice before the class starts.

A Detailed Introduction to Fusing

This five-week course gives the student the opportunity to explore many of the facets of fusing. As well as a really interesting and fun experience for the novice, this is an ideal opportunity for the person contemplating investing in their own kiln to try out this art-form within an art-form. Fusing opens many avenues of artistic expression and this course lets you see some of the possibilities.

Within the cost of the course we have included the supplies for 4 fused coasters (Week One). Supplies for the remaining four weeks will be additional as students will have their choice of fusing glass which varies in price.

The five-week schedule consists of:-

Week 1 – A set of Four fused coasters.

Week 2 – Two Fused Night Lights.

Week 3 – One 8" x 8" plate.

Week 4 – Larger Bowl, various mold shapes are available to select from.

Week 5 – Vase.

Studio Time

Do you have a project to complete? Want to do something for that special someone without them finding out? Need a working space and the use of a grinder at an affordable rate? Just want to get out of the house before you cause someone serious harm?

If you should take advantage of our studio time, arrive when you like and work as long as you like. Student must have their own small tools (cutter, grozing pliers, runner, and burnisher). Use of Grinders and Soldering Irons is provided along with workspace.

Cutting Clinic

Frustrated with your glass cutting skills? Wasting valuable glass with bad cuts? Come along to the Cutting Clinic and hone up your cutting skills. This is a practical but rewarding workshop. Bring along your cutter and tools to be checked out.

Soldering Clinic

Soldering is the key to quality stained glass; if you suffer from “solder envy” you should attend this 2-hour workshop. Bring along your own soldering iron, stand, solder and a small foiled project and we will help you “iron” out your soldering problems and brush up your skills.

NEW Parent (Grandparent) and Child - Two Fused Night Lights

Fusing is great for all ages, parents (grandparents) and child work side by side to create a night light each. This is a great way to spend quality time with your child. Fusing will be carried out after the class and the completed projects will be available to collect in a few days. Night Light clips will be applied by the helpful Hues In Glass staff and all you need to do when you get home is plug it in. (one parent (grandparent) must be present for every two children)

Suitable for 5 to 12 years, younger children considered on a case by case basis.

NEW Wine Glass Tea-Light Holder

Six Sided Panel Lamp

A class designed for intermediate students.

Basic stained glass skills are required for this course.

Jewelry Fusing

Learn to use dichroic glass, gold and dichroic slides, and copper inclusions to create a one of a kind piece of jewelry. You will learn how to use fibre paper, and copper wire to replace bails, basic wire wrapping will be demonstrated. Make 6-8 pieces of jewelry.
